## WHEN WORKERS ARE DENIED CLAIMS

If you have been injured on the job and find yourself confronted with a workers' compensation carrier who denies your legitimate claim, you should not let the matter rest. The insurer may claim that you have not been injured at all or that your injury is not serious enough to qualify you for disability. The insurer may issue these denials on the basis of the findings of its own private investigation. As aggressive as their stance may be, if your legitimate benefits are denied, you should plan to vigorously pursue your claim. At the same time, it is probably in your best interest to hire an attorney, who can help you pursue your claim.
