Pet owners may be liable for injuries caused by their pets if they knew (or should have known) that the animal was likely to cause the type of injury that occurred. Thus, a person who has been injured by an animal may base his or her claim of liability on the animal's past behavior as a means of providing evidence that the owner should have known of the danger presented by his or her pet. On the other hand, if it can be shown that the animal possessed some inborn predisposition toward aggressive behavior, the party injured by the animal may be able to recover compensation without proving any prior incidents of biting.
