by George Allen Moore Injury Attorney COMPENSATION FOR LOSS OR INJURY

If you experience loss, injury, or harm as the result of another party's actions, and win your civil case against that party, you are entitled to receive compensation. This monetary award takes the form of "special damages," which include compensation for past and future medical bills and lost wages, and "general damages," which cannot be so precisely calculated. They include compensation for the pain and suffering, past and future, endured by the injured party. In addition, there are "punitive damages." Not available in all states, they uphold the principle that a negligent party may be held liable for more money than it would take to compensate the inured party, serving as

a warning to other negligent wrongdoers.
