## COMPENSATION FOR ON-THE-JOB INJURIES

Workers who are injured on the job or contract a work-induced illness can seek certain benefits through worker's compensation. This no-fault system is designed so that the injured employee can file for benefits rather than sue the employer. In cases of extreme negligence, an injured worker may want to consult with a lawyer about filing a suit. A lawyer may be needed in cases where workers' claims are accepted but they don't receive the correct amount or the employer retaliates against a worker by instituting disciplinary action or terminating employment. There are also cases in which care is denied the

worker or the case goes to appeal. These and other factors should prompt an injured worker to seek legal help.
